September – Getting Ready for School

Building classroom routines, self-awareness, emotional regulation, and friendship skills.

October – Fall & Exploration

Exploring seasonal changes, pumpkins, leaves, nature, and weather through hands-on discovery.

November – Family & Community

Learning about families, community helpers, gratitude, and healthy nutrition habits.

December – Winter & Traditions

Exploring winter weather, holidays around the world, kindness, giving, and celebrating learning.

January – New Beginnings

Setting goals, exploring snow and ice, learning about winter animals, and Arctic adventures.



February – Love & Friendship

Developing friendship skills, kindness, healthy habits, and emotional awareness.

March – Growth & Discovery

Investigating spring changes, plants, seeds, life cycles, weather, and rain.

April – Nature & Science

Learning about Earth, recycling, bugs, insects, and outdoor exploration through hands-on STEM activities.

May – Learning & Moving Forward

Exploring transportation, safety, reviewing skills, and preparing for kindergarten.

June – Summer Fun & Review


Enjoying water play, animals, outdoor exploration, and celebrating learning achievements.

July – Summer Transition & Social Skills

Strengthening routines, self-awareness, friendship skills, creativity, and exploration through play.

August – School Readiness & Review

Reviewing letters, numbers, shapes, social skills, problem-solving, independence, and kindergarten readiness.
